



Instrumentation Technician

Physical requirements

The physical demands described are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

Position requires physical effort such as that associated with driving a motorized vehicle, using hand tools, and typing on a computer. Position requires repetitive stair climbing, moderate lifting (30-50lbs), occasional need to walk on irregular surfaces, wrist and arm movements. Also requires connecting and disconnecting of valves and hoses, gauging instruments, wires, and using the corresponding tools.

Work Environment: The work environment characteristics described are representative of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

Position exposes employee to outdoor weather conditions, which may sometimes be hazardous, as well as exhaust and other unpleasant fumes.

The above noted job description is not intended to describe, in detail, the multitude of tasks that may be assigned but rather to give the associate a general sense of the responsibilities and expectations of his/her position. As the nature of business demands change so, too, may the essential functions of this position
